RESOLUTION NO. 2024-21

BOARD OF SANITARY COMMISSIONERS MUNCIE SANITARY DISTRICT

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners, as the governing body of the Muncie Sanitary District (the "District"), is authorized to establish fees and charges for certain services performed by the District's personnel using the District's equipment; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Sanitary Commissioners now desires to establish a fee for the performance of sewer line inspections when such inspections are requested by the customer and performed by the District's personnel using the District's equipment.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Muncie Sanitary District, Delaware County, State of Indiana, that:

- 1. The permit/inspection fees for new sewer connections will be \$100 plus \$1 per linear foot of 8-inch and larger diameter pipe that would become property of MSD.
- 2. The tap-in fee for sewer connections will be \$800 per ERU (equivalent residential unit = 310 gal./day) rounded to the nearest 0.1 ERU.
- 3. The permit/inspection fee for stormwater connections will be \$150 plus \$0.50 per linear foot of 12" or larger diameter pipe that will become property of the MSD.
- 4. The tap-in fee for stormwater connections will be \$150 each plus \$50 per additional ERU (equivalent residential unit = 2500 sq. ft.) rounded to the nearest 0.1 ERU.
- 5. The fees set forth herein are in addition to any other inspection and/or permit fees that may be applicable to the customer or their sewer lines.

- 6. All provisions in any other ordinances, resolutions, and regulations in direct conflict with the provisions set forth in this Resolution are hereby repealed.
- 7. This Resolution shall be in full force and effect upon its adoption and publication as required by law.

The foregoing Resolution No. 2024-21 is hereby approved by the Board of Sanitary Commissioners of the Muncie Sanitary District on this, the 11th day of December 2024.
